If a journal article has a DOI, include the DOI in the reference. Always include the issue number for a journal article. If the journal article does not have a DOI and is from an academic research database, end the reference after the page range (for an explanation of why, see the database information page).The reference in this case is the same as for a print journal article.

The essential elements you require to create a journal article reference include: Author or authors including surname and initial. [Call out: include the second initial if available]; Year of publication, Title of article.

A basic reference list entry for a journal article in APA must include: Author or authors. The surname is followed by first initials. Year of publication of the article (in round brackets). Article title. Journal title (in italics). Volume of journal (in italics). Issue number of journal in round brackets (no italics). Page range of article ...

### **Journal Articles - APA 7th Referencing - Library Guides at ...**

Reference List. In-text Citation. Basic Format: Last name, A. A. (Year). Title of article. Title of Journal, Volume number (issue number if available), pages. Example: Scruton, R. (1996). The eclipse of listening. *The New Criterion*, 15(3), 5-13. Note: The name of the author is reversed with the last name first followed by the initials.

### **APA Journal Citation | APA Format**

Author names, if available, will always come first in your reference page for APA citation for journal articles. Start your reference page citation with the last name of the first author followed by a comma, followed by the author's capitalized first initial and a period. Then list the author's middle initial if one is provided followed by ...

Journal – APA Reference List Capitalization. The title of article is in sentence case – Only the first word and proper nouns in the title are capitalized. Always capitalize the first word, the first word after a colon or a dash. The journal title is in title case – Each word in the title is capitalized, except for articles (a, an, the), prepositions (against, between, in, of, to ...

Use p. to reference a single page, and pp. for a range of pages. If you are referencing a journal article which you have read online (on a website or as a PDF), you do not need to include [online], the URL or the access date in your reference.

Citing a Journal Article in MLA (found in databases) The following are examples of how to cite a journal in MLA 8, both in text and as a full reference in the Works Cited. These were all found via a database. Note that "Date Accessed" is the day that the journal article was found and read. Including this date is optional.

Journal publishers now assign DOIs to articles before they are published in a specific journal issue, so you can use the DOI provided for postprint / in press articles. This will ensure that the correct link for the article remains when it is moved to a specific journal issue.

Include an in-text citation when you refer to, summarize, paraphrase, or quote from another source. For every in-text citation in your paper, there must be a corresponding entry in your reference list. APA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005).

### **In-text Citation - APA Quick Citation Guide - Library ...**

More than one reference from the same author(s) in the same year must be identified by the letters 'a', 'b', 'c', etc., placed after the year of publication. Examples: Reference to a journal publication: Van der Geer, J., Hanraads, J.A.J., Lupton, R.A., 2010. The art of writing a scientific article.

The reference and bibliographic style of the AAS Journals generally requires that references should be cited in the text by the last name of the author(s) and the date of publication, with no comma before the date, according to these examples: articles by three or more authors are cited by the first author followed by "et al." and the date (Goodman et al. 2003); articles by two authors ...
