Transactional Analysis (or TA as it is often called) is a model of people and relationships that was developed during the 1960s by Dr. Eric Berne. It is based on two notions, first that we have three parts or 'ego-states' to our 'personality, and secondly that these converse with one another in 'transactions' (hence the name).

Transactional Analysis - Changing minds

Martin (2004) suggested that transactional analysis provides four essential steps to reaching a peaceful conflict resolution: (1) Centering yourself, (2) Connecting with the aggressor, (3) Channeling the attack so that neither you nor your aggressor gets hurt, and (4) Safely concluding the interaction.
